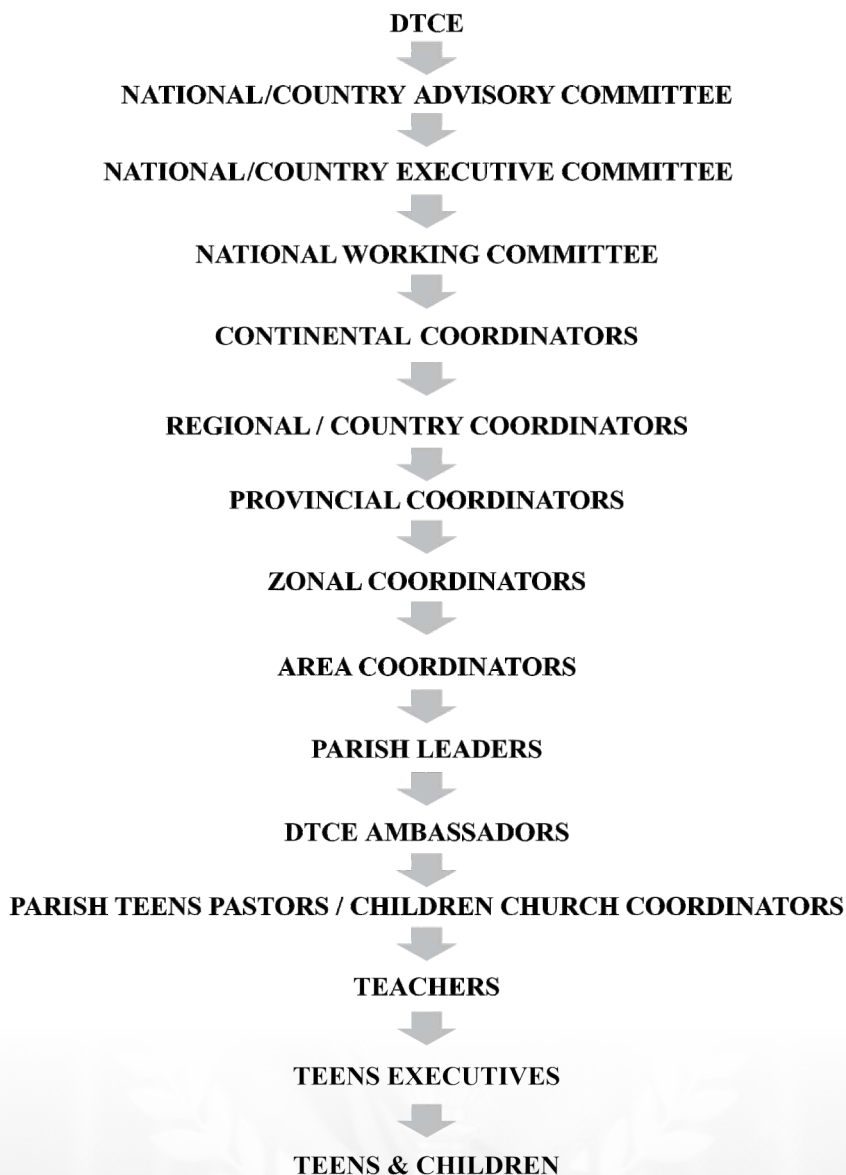
DIRECTORATE OF TEENS & CHILDREN EDUCATION RCCG VISION 2032 - DTCE STRATEGIES FOR JUNIOR CHURCH

1. One-on-One Witnessing especially the teenagers.
2. Street evangelism / crusade with CSR (Christian Social Responsibilities activities) to win souls for Christ.
3. Establishment of Evangelism & Follow Up Unit and Secondary School Outreach Unit in all Provinces & Regions.
4. Encourage our Teens to use Social Media platforms for evangelism - Short drama videos, Gospel messages, Biblical quotes, Gospel fliers and tracts, programmes publicity & jingles, etc.
5. Organizing programmes that are evangelistic oriented for the teens and children.
6. Effective Follow up strategies for the new converts and new comers to remain in the Junior Church.
7. Bible Clubs in our neighborhood where teens and children will be invited.
8. Develop a robust reporting mechanism to capture the junior church evangelism activities to DTCE and then to National Vision 2032 Committee.
9. Organizing Power pack programs in our Junior Church that will sustain our Teens & children in the church. Including developing our teenagers through trainings such as Baptismal Class, Workers in Training, School of Disciples Course, Leadership Courses, etc. And creating enabling environment for them to worship God.
10. Engaging and involving the Teens and the children in the church services, helping them identify their talents and encouraging them to use their talents for God.

Above are the 10 strategies the Junior Church will pursue to contribute our quota to the realization of 40 million Souls as a mandate of RCCG Vision 2032. We therefore need the encouragement and support of the Mission, Pastors, Coordinators, Teachers, Parents and the Teens and Children of RCCG to actualize this mandate.
